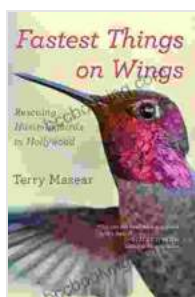

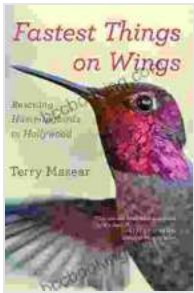
Emerald
