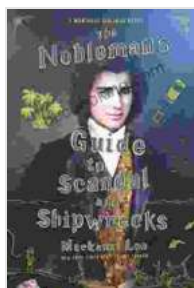


The Nobleman's Guide to Scandal and Shipwrecks: A Review

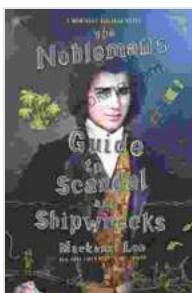
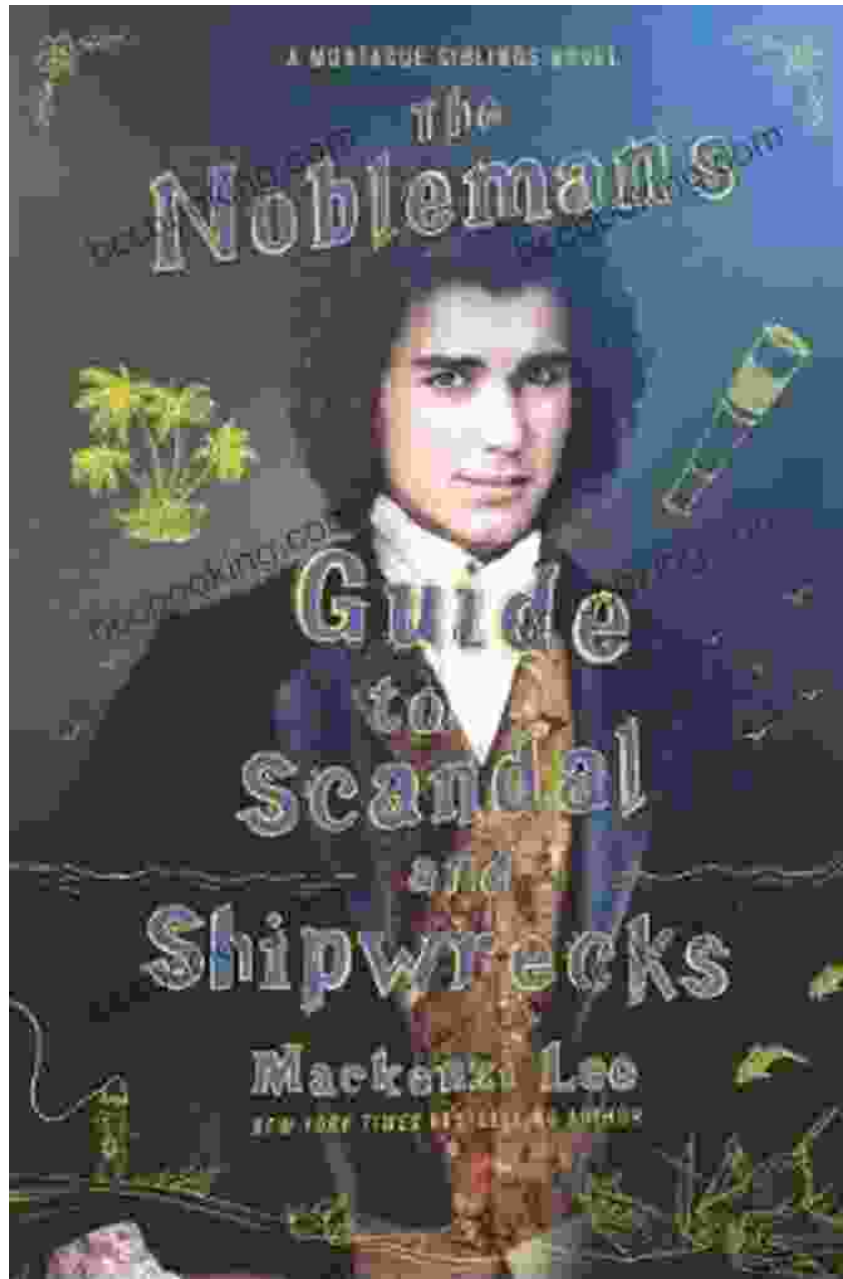
If you're a fan of Regency romances, historical romances, or just well-written books in general, then you'll love *The Nobleman's Guide to Scandal and Shipwrecks*.
